The format of a **letter to the editor of a Newspaper** is as follows –

1. Sender's address: The address and contact details of the sender are written here. Include email and phone number, if required or if mentioned in the question.
2. Date: The date is written below the sender's address after Leaving one space or line.
3. Receiving Editor's address: The address of the recipient of the mail i.e. the editor is written here.
4. Subject of the letter: The main purpose of the letter forms the subject. It must be written in one line. It must convey the matter for which the letter is written.
5. Salutation (Sir / Respected sir / Madam)
6. Body: The matter of the letter is written here. It is divided into 3 paragraphs as follows -
Paragraph 1: Introduce yourself and the purpose of writing the letter in brief.
Paragraph 2: Give a detail of the matter.
Paragraph 3: Conclude by mentioning what you expect from the editor. (For example, you may want him to highlight the issue in his newspaper / magazine).
7. Complimentary Closing
8. Sender's name, signature and designation(if any)

Previously, the residents used to get water for about three hours in the morning and three hours in the evening. But now the taps go dry even during the morning hours. It has put the residents to great inconvenience. Many have to go without their daily bath and wash. In order to improve the water supply, the MC must take some urgent steps. It is suggested that a couple of new tube-wells should be dug in the area to meet the demand of the residents. Watering the plants in house gardens should strictly be disallowed during the morning hours. Water metres should be installed at all houses to stop the wasteful use of water. All these steps, taken together, can go a long way in improving the condition of water supply in this area.
