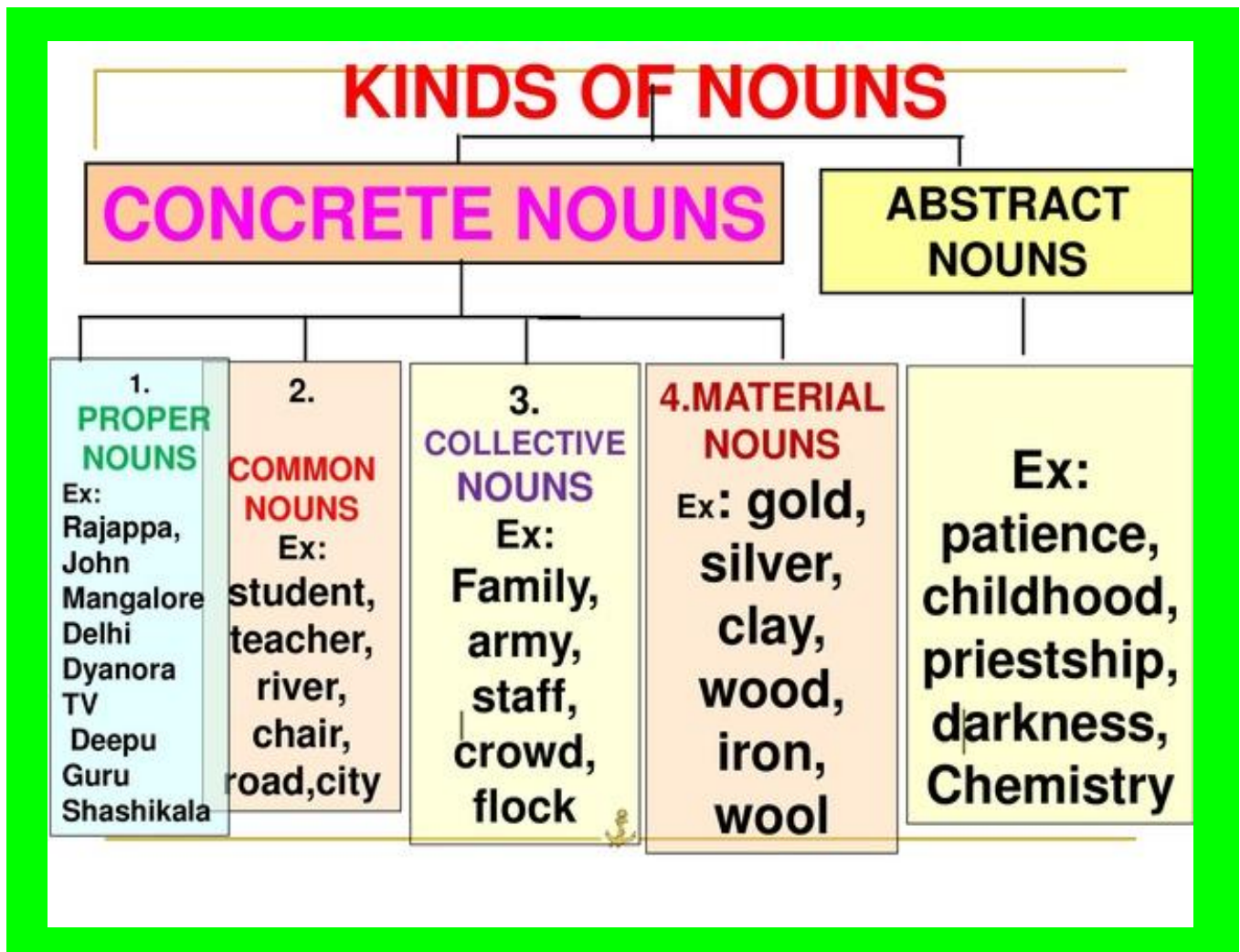

A noun is the name of person, place, thing or animal.



PROPER NOUN

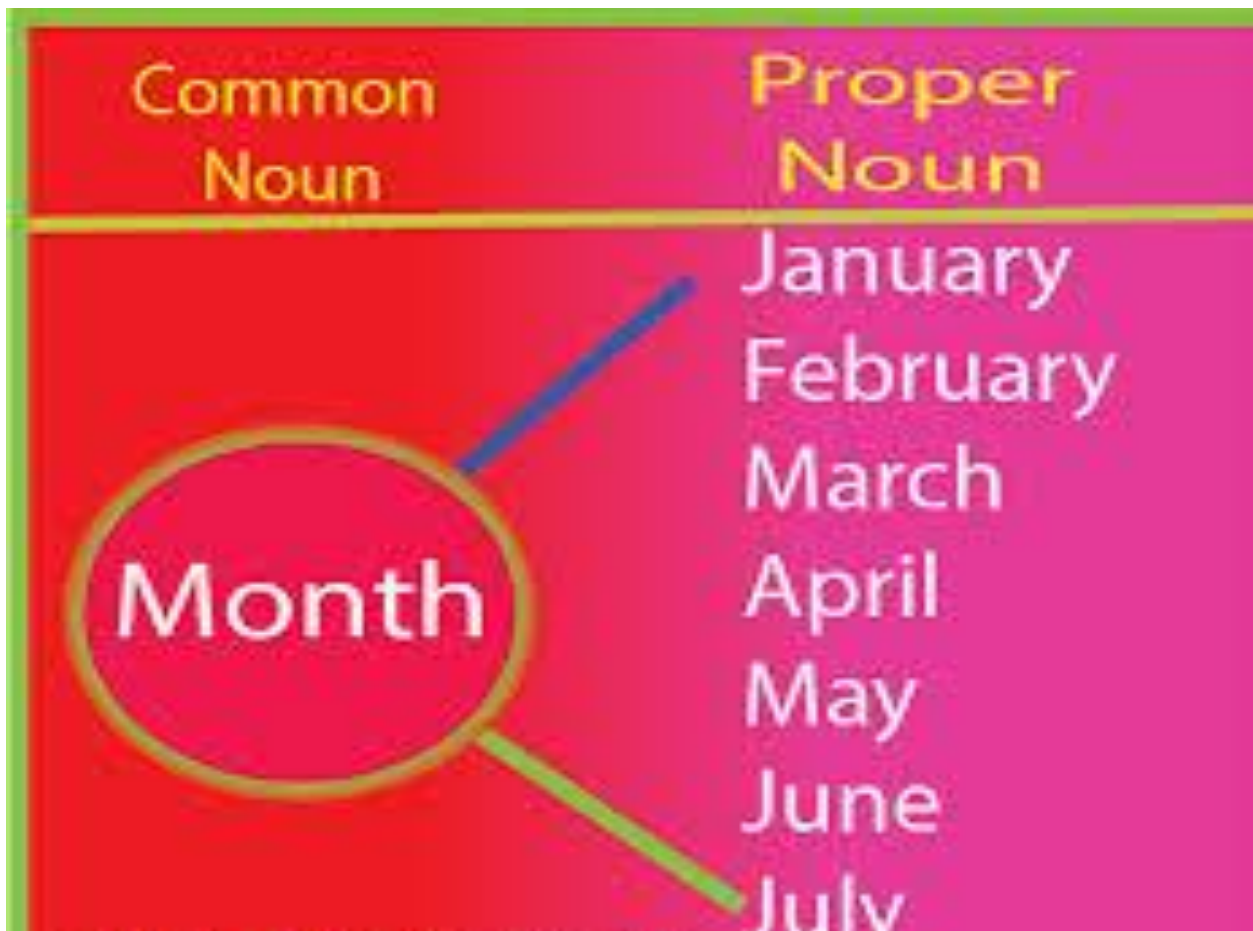
Proper noun is the name of a particular person, place, animal or thing.

Example- Mayank Mumbai

COMMON NOUN

Common noun is the general name given to every person, place, animal or thing.

Example- boy king school city



COLLECTIVE NOUN

A Collective noun is the name given to a group of people, places animals or things taken together as one.

MATERIAL NOUN

A material noun denotes the matter of substance of which things are made.

Example – gold rubber glass milk

A material noun is a name of a substance as a whole.

Examples of Material Nouns

- **Material nouns from nature:** water, air, silver, gold, iron, copper, sand, coal, rock, sunlight, rain, earth, salt, etc.
- **Material nouns from animals:** egg, meat, honey, milk, silk, leather, wool, etc.
- **Material nouns from plants:** cotton, food, oil, wood, jute, coffee, medicine, tea, rubber, perfume, etc.
- **Man made material nouns:** acid, alcohol, asphalt, brick, cement, butter, chalk, ghee, cheese, dacron, ebony, enamel, felt, gelatin, paraffin, cloth, etc.

ABSTRACT NOUN

An abstract noun is the name of a quality, action or the state of an object.

Example – honesty pride bravery truth
